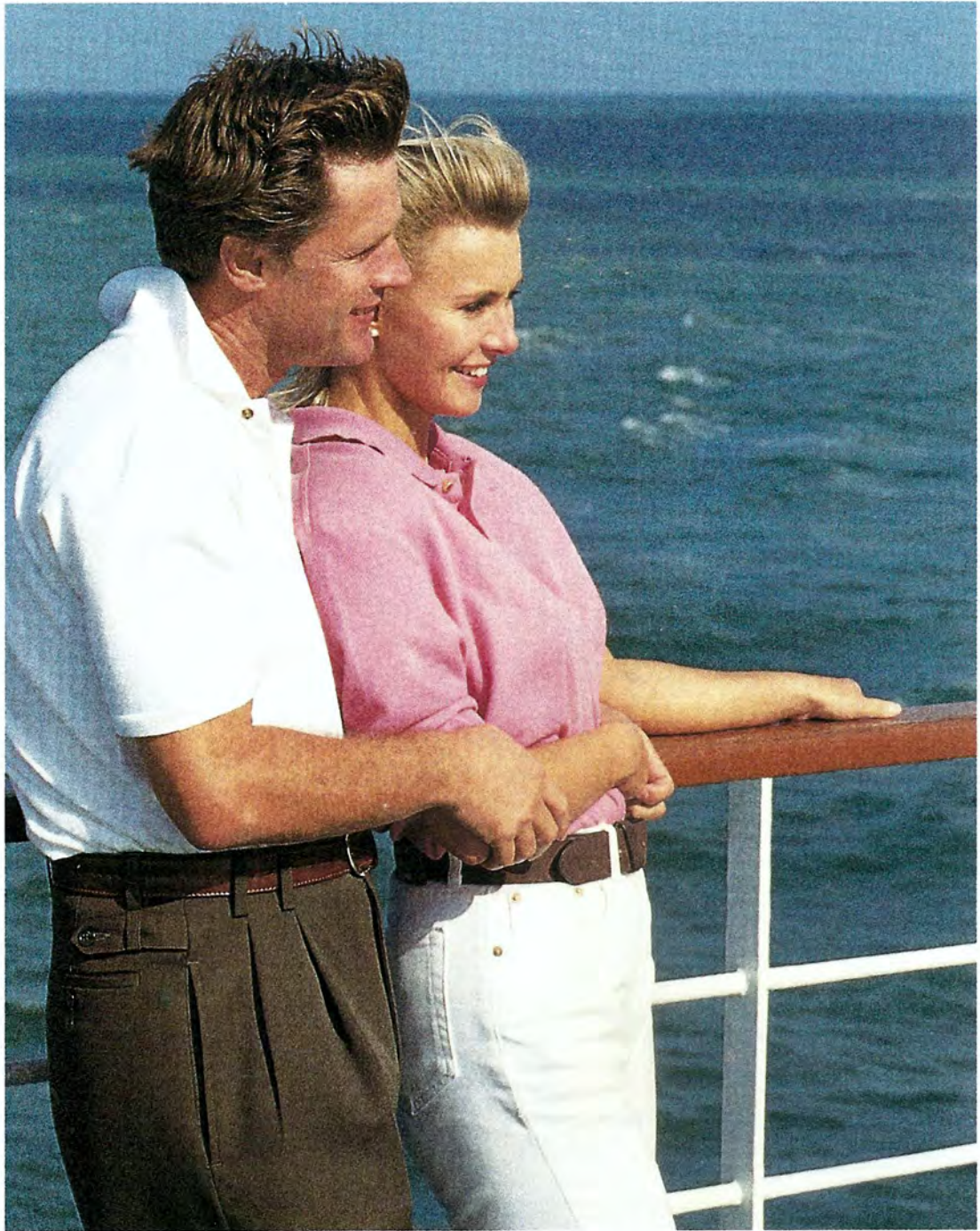

Ships on the Ramsgate-Ostend route include the latest in luxury superferries, Prins Filip. Or for those foot passengers in a hurry there's the Jetfoil service.

So on the Ramsgate-Dunkerque route, 2-8 year olds can play in our crèche under the watchful eye of our qualified nanny, while there is a fully equipped playroom on the ships sailing to Ostend.

FUSS-FREE ROUTES

TAKE THE EASY WAY OUT

There's no easier port to find than Ramsgate. From London, take the M2 then the A299. Travelling from outside London, you can take the M25 which joins the M2.

In Ramsgate, you'll find that Sally's own dedicated terminal cuts out congestion and ensures quick, easy boarding and disembarkation. A relaxing crossing of 2 1/2 hours takes you to Dunkerque. A leisurely 4 hour crossing, or a rather more rapid 105 minute Jetfoil flight sees you in Ostend.

From both ports, you'll find main roads and motorways close at hand to get you on your way to your final destination.

Dunkerque has an excellent motorway link to Paris and the south. With its restaurants and cafés, it's also a great choice for a day trip.

Ostend is a convenient start for those travelling to Holland, Luxembourg, Germany or on to Switzerland or Austria. With superb restaurants and sandy beaches it's also ideal for a short break.



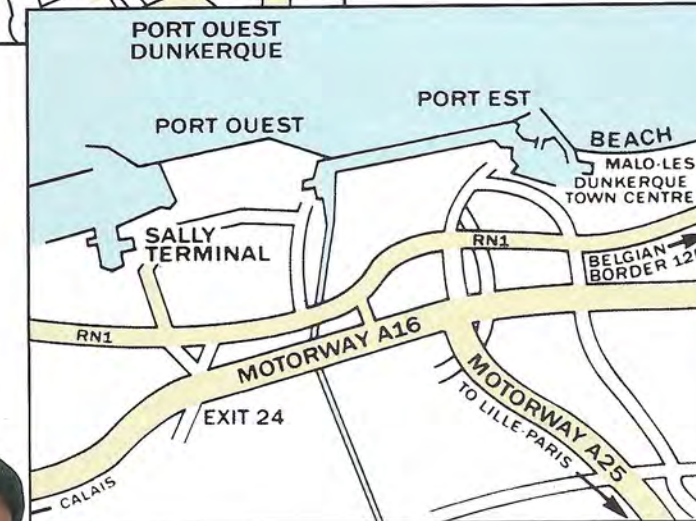
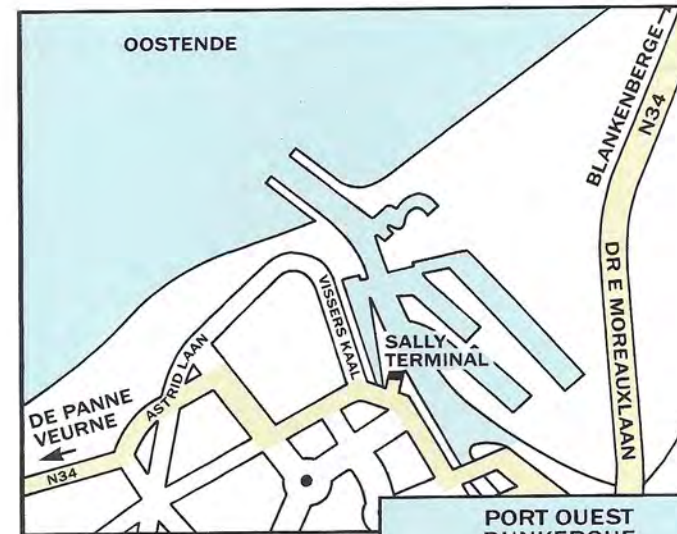

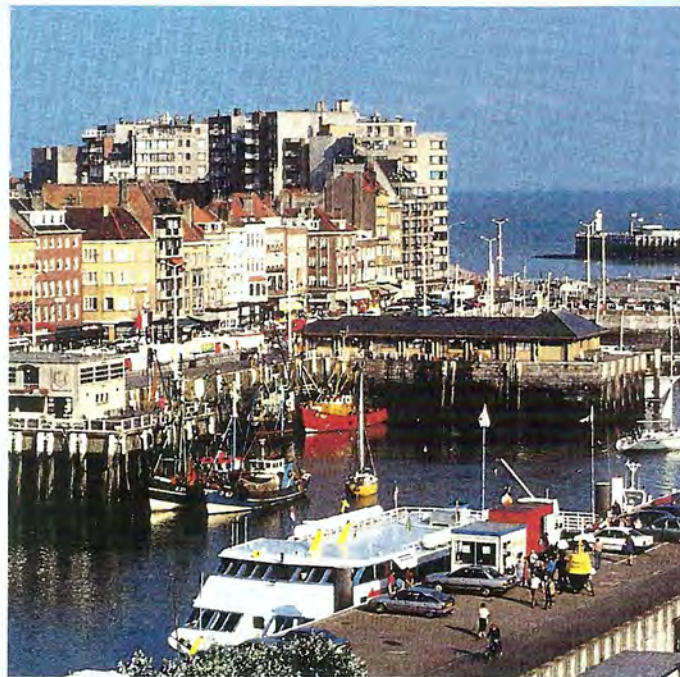
FROM DUNKERQUE

The attraction of Dunkerque for the motorist is the newly constructed A16 autoroute which takes you onto the A25 to Lille, with easy access from there to the European motorway network.

FROM OSTEND

Ostend is the natural choice for motorists heading for Brussels, Amsterdam, Bonn, Basle, or Vienna. Just head for the A10 (E40) for Brussels. Those travelling to Switzerland should take the A4 to Luxembourg, the A31 to Nancy and the N57 to Basle.

Ostend also provides a good link to Austria via the A10 and A13 to Bonn and Frankfurt.

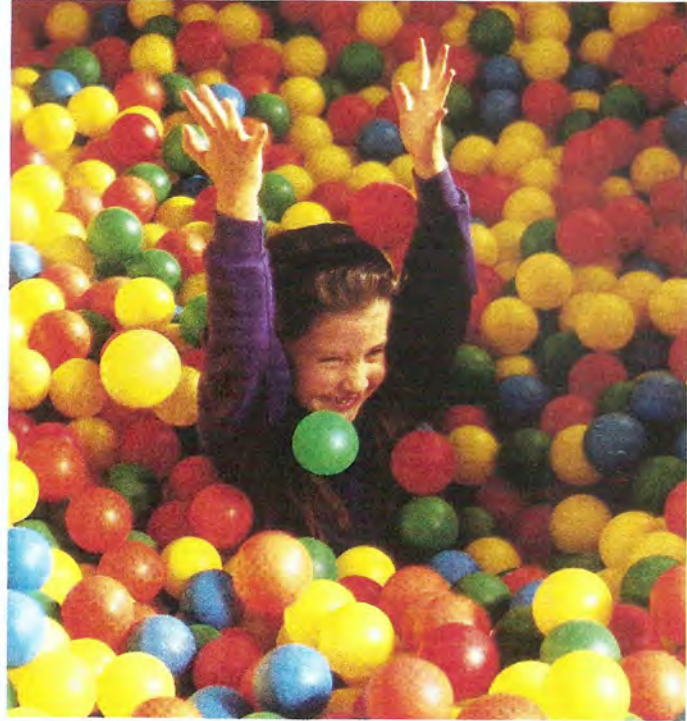


...AND FOR OUR OSTEND PASSENGERS

HOW TO WORK OUT YOUR FARE

First, select the relevant price panel depending on whether your journey is a single, or a five day or standard return. Then find your sailing dates and times, and determine the colour codes of the outward and return journey.

Match your colour code with the appropriate tariff band. If your colour codes are different for the outward and return journey, refer to note 1.

Lastly, decide how many adults and children are travelling. If travelling by car or by car and caravan determine the overall length - see notes 2 and 3.

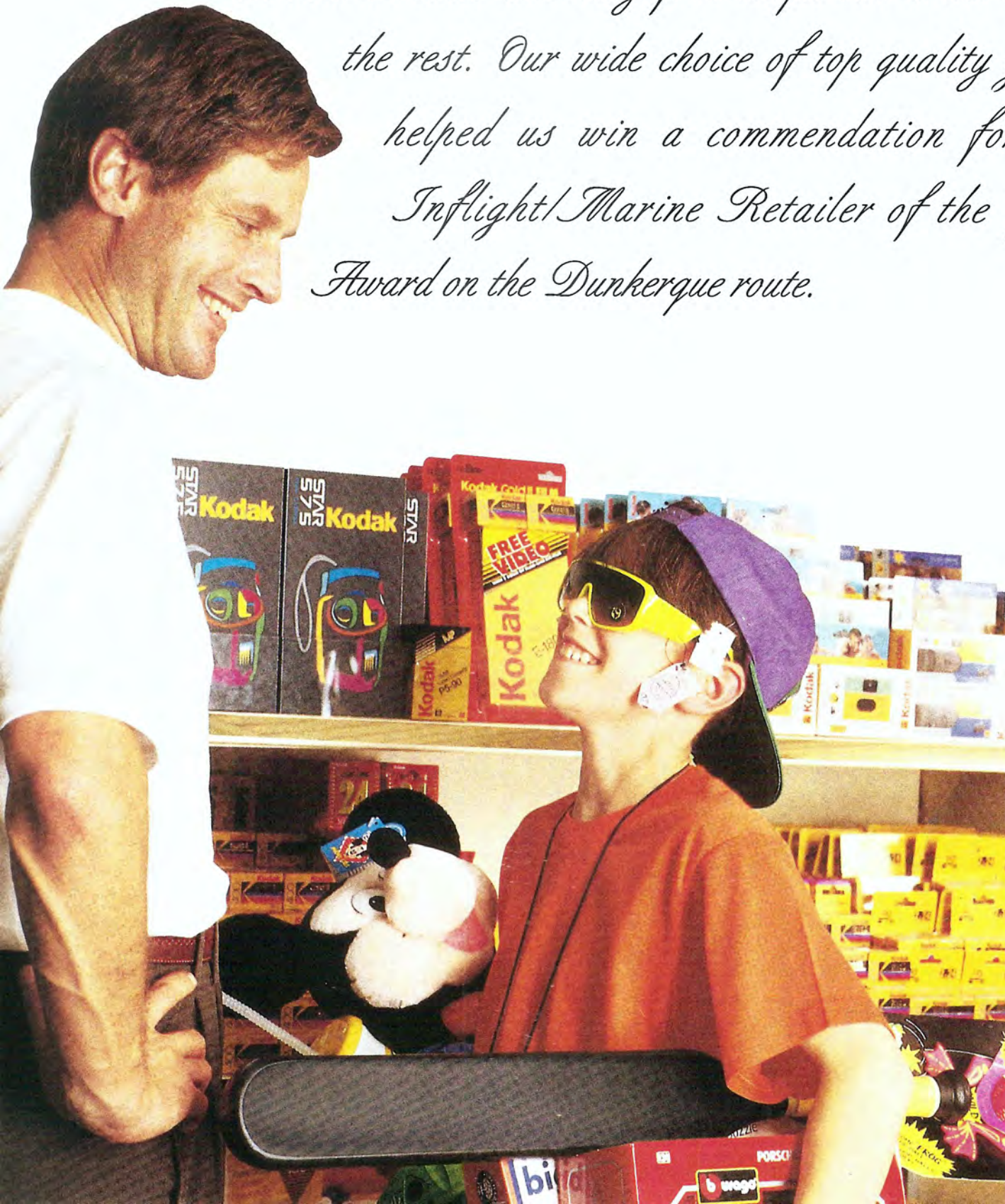

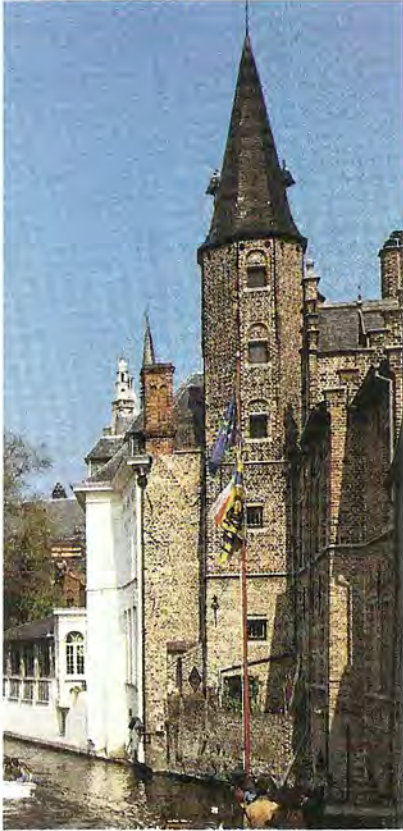

4 REFUNDS

7 CURRENCY FLUCTUATIONS

13 VISA/PASSPORTS

A valid passport is required by all passengers travelling to and from the UK. For some non-EEC passport holders, French law also requires a visa for entry into France, which can be obtained from French Consulate General, Visa Section, 6-8 Cromwell Road, London, SW7. Please note: visas for entry into France cannot be obtained in advance from local consulate offices, nor at the border on arrival in France. Visas may also be required for entry into the UK. This does not apply to passport holders from EEC countries, USA or Australia, but if you are at all unsure, please seek further advice from any British Immigration Office, British High Commission or British Consulate.

14 SECURITY

For the protective security of all passengers in accordance with the Aviation and Maritime Security Act 1990 (AMSA) as required by HM Government in furtherance of the provision of AMSA you and your property (including the vehicle in which you are travelling) may be searched by the authorised security authority before you are permitted to proceed for embarkation.
